

## TYPES OF WORKPLACE VIOLENCE

According to a study in the New England Journal of Medicine, there are 4 types of violence that can occur in the workplace:

- 1. The assailant has no association with the workplace or employee.
- 2. The assailant is a customer or a patient of the workplace or employee.
- 3. The assailant is a current or former employee of the workplace.
- 4. The assailant has a personal relationship with the employee but not with the workplace.

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
